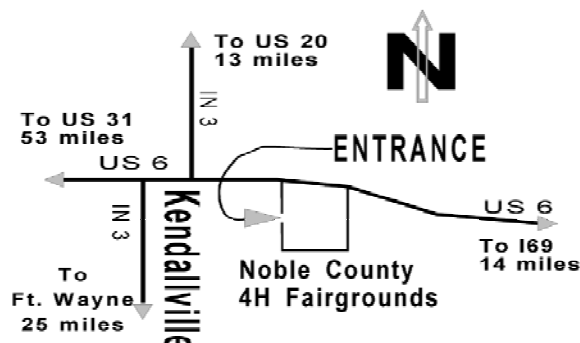

Festival rules that you should respect

- Respect your neighbors and **limit** conversations in the concert area
- No smoking** under the concert tents, pavilion or in any building
- Pets are not allowed in the concert area. Pets must be leashed or enclosed in vehicles or cages in all other areas. Owners of any pet creating a disturbance or continually barking may be asked to remove the pet from the festival grounds. **Use of a poop scoop** is required
- High back chairs are allowed only in the last rows of the concert area. You may keep an empty chair warm until the owner returns.
- All vehicles with daily stickers must be out by 8 AM the following day. Daily parking is on the race track infield.
- No alcohol** in the concert area
- Excessive noise, use of foul language or other rowdy behavior will not be tolerated and will be grounds for ejection from the festival with no refund
- No canned music** that can be heard at an adjacent campsite
- Handicap facilities & services are available. Private, single person, handicap vehicles are allowed. **NO GOLF CARTS** other than NIBGA golf carts. There are two 4 seater NIBGA golf carts that are used as taxis. Call 419-721-8016 to get a taxi to your car/camp
- Use of bicycles is limited to daylight hours and no bicycles in the midway area between the stage and grandstand
- No piggybacking of electrical cords, limit one vehicle/cord per plug-in socket. No A/C, electric heaters, etc. — 15 amp shared service
- Tents in the electric areas must be tightly grouped, next to rigs
- No tents or camping in any building per Indiana Fire Marshall
- No campfires within 50' any building. Place unburned wood next to trees or fence. No camp stoves, bottle gas or gasoline in buildings. **Do not bring firewood** because of emerald ash borer beetle.
- No roping off camp sites; One vehicle per camping unit per camp site. Other vehicles should be parked on the track
- Generators are allowed only in the designated area on the east side of the race track
- Minors must camp with, and be supervised by, an adult
- The dump station is located south of the main gate between the cinder block rest rooms
- Showers are located in three rest room areas, the cinder block RR adjacent to Fair St., the RR south of the Log Cabin and the horse & pony track RR NE of stage
- Under the terms of admission, you enter the grounds on your own responsibility and assume all related risks
- All federal, state, and local laws apply
