

- ☑ Respect your neighbors and **limit** conversations in the concert area
- ☑ **No smoking** under the concert tents or pavilion
- ☑ Pets are not allowed in the concert area. Pets must be leashed or enclosed in vehicles or cages in all other areas. Owners of any pet creating a disturbance or continually barking may be asked to remove the pet from the festival grounds. **Use** of a **poop scoop** is required
- ☑ Concert chairs area are to be stacked or removed after the last show for cleaning. Chairs can be set up again at 8 AM the following day. High back chairs are allowed in the last row of the concert area
- ☑ All vehicles with daily stickers must be out by 8 AM the following day. Daily parking is on the race track
- ☑ **No alcohol** in the concert area
- ☑ Excessive noise, use of foul language or other rowdy behavior will not be tolerated and will be grounds for ejection from the festival with no refund
- ☑ **No canned music** that can be heard at an adjacent campsite
- ☑ Handicap facilities and services are available. Use of private, single person, handicap vehicles is allowed. **NO GOLF CARTS**
- ☑ No unlicensed motorized vehicles allowed other than NIBGA golf carts
- ☑ Use of bicycles is limited to daylight hours and no bicycles in the midway area between the stage and grandstand
- ☑ No piggybacking of electrical cords allowed, limit one vehicle/cord per plug-in socket. No A/C, electric heaters, etc. — 15 amp shared service
- ☑ No campfires within 50 feet of any building. Please place unburned wood next to trees or fence. No camp stoves, bottle gas or gasoline in buildings
- ☑ No roping off camp sites
- ☑ One vehicle per camping unit per camp site. Other vehicles should be parked on the track
- ☑ Generators are allowed only in the designated area on the east side of the race track
- ☑ Minors must camp with, and be supervised by, a responsible adult
- ☑ The dump station is located south of the main gate between the cinder block rest rooms. Honey wagon service \$7
- ☑ Showers are located in three rest room areas, the cinder block RR adjacent to Fair St., the RR south of the Log Cabin and the horse & pony track RR on the northeast end
- ☑ Under the terms of admission, you enter the grounds on your own responsibility and assume all related risks
- ☑ All federal, state, and local laws apply
